

Dear Parents, Class of 2023,

We look forward to the graduation of the Class of 2023 on June 13th. This joyous rite of passage will be a memorable, momentous and meaningful experience. We have compiled a list of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) which we hope will answer all your questions.

**\*What time is Graduation?**

Graduation is scheduled for 6:00 pm. Gates open at 5:30 pm.

**\*Where is Graduation taking place?**

Graduation takes place outdoors at the Gladys and Sam z"l Halpern Amphitheater on the Bat Sheva and Murray Halpern Field.

**\*What times should graduates arrive?**

Graduates should arrive by 5:00 pm dressed in caps and gowns, ready for a grade photograph in the Zuckerman Family Gymnasium.

**\*How many seats will each graduate be allocated?**

Each graduate can bring up to 6 guests seated in one group on the field.

**\*What if I need additional seats for my family?**

[Click here](#) for the form to request additional seats [before June 6th](#). Additional seats beyond the allotted six seats will be located in a separate area on the field to enable all families to have an equitable experience.

**\*How will I know where to sit?**

Family seating will be determined by an online randomizer. Seats will be clearly marked with the name of each graduating senior. Faculty will be available to help you find your seats. Extra seating will be non-reserved.

**\*What if the forecast predicts rain?**

In the event of inclement weather, graduation will be held in the Epstein-Stein Auditorium. If we are compelled to move graduation indoors, families will receive 5 tickets each for the auditorium. Overflow seating will be available in the Multi Purpose Room.

**\*How long is graduation?**

The graduation ceremony will last approximately one and a half hours. A parve collation will follow in the Gottlieb Family Pavilion (or the Jocheved Orbach Dining Hall should graduation take place inside).

**\*Is there a bathroom outside?**

Bathrooms will be available in the snack shack on the southwest corner of the Gottlieb Family Pavilion.

**\*My relatives do not live locally. How can they watch the graduation ceremony?**

The graduation ceremony will be recorded and posted on our YouTube channel after the completion of graduation.

**\*Will there be a professional photographer?**

Zush Heinrich of Zee Photography will take photographs of each graduate as they receive their diplomas. He will also be available during the reception for family photographs. A link to purchase photographs will be sent to you at a later date.

**\*Is there a dress code?**

Attire is casual while considering the heat of the day at an outdoor event. Seniors and guests are asked to not wear high-heeled shoes which could damage the turf and could cause injury. Sunglasses, hats and sunscreen are recommended.

**\*Will there be a mincha minyan?**

Yes, there will be a mincha minyan after the ceremony.
