

JKHA Summer - Parent Acknowledgment and Release

I hereby acknowledge and agree to the following conditions applying to my registering for, and sending my child to, the 2020 JKHA Summer Program (“JKHA Summer”; which includes reference to the staff and administration of JKHA Summer). I understand that the following representations and commitments are reasonable and appropriate in light of the current medical, legal and economic conditions resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, and to mitigate the health risks to my child and other participants in the program, and I accept the resulting risks and implications for my child and my family:

1. Though JKHA Summer will use its reasonable best efforts to keep my child safe and healthy while they are participating in the program, JKHA Summer will not be able to control all applicable risks, and cannot promise or guarantee against my child being exposed to COVID-19 through their participation in JKHA Summer. In fact, the very nature of the personal interaction anticipated to occur during the program does expose my child to a risk of illness.
2. My child will be subject to the JKHA Summer COVID-19 Policies and Procedures, as they may be amended from time to time at the sole discretion of JKHA Summer (the “Procedures”), and will be obligated to comply with such Procedures.
3. The Procedures may dictate circumstances under which my child may be sent home from the program and/or instructed not to attend the program for a specified period of time (that may require first providing evidence of a COVID-19 test with negative results), and that if contacted during a day of programming I will arrange to pick up my child from the program as soon as possible after being requested to do so.
4. Though JKHA Summer is confident of its ability to open and operate this program in a manner that meets applicable safety standards, including those of the New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH), such standards are subject to ongoing and abrupt changes, and as a result JKHA Summer may implement changes to address the latest safety standards. With respect to testing for COVID-19, JKHA Summer current policy is to only accept results of testing via the method known as the PCR Nasal Swab test, and that if the Procedures mandate testing it may demand use of this form of test and refuse to recognize results from any other type of COVID-19 test results.
5. I will not send my child to any day of JKHA Summer, and I will notify JKHA Summer, if I have reason to believe that my child may be infected with COVID-19 or any other communicable disease, including if they are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 recognized by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) - such symptoms include elevated fever or chills, cough, fatigue, or sore throat; see <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html>
6. Sending my child to JKHA Summer poses a risk to myself, my family, and to others, and I commit during the term of the program and for two weeks thereafter to use best efforts to minimize my child’s contact with persons identified by the CDC as needing to take extra precautions - that includes people that are immunocompromised, older adults, and people with asthma; see [People Who Need to Take Extra Precautions](#).
7. I am exclusively responsible for daily transportation to and from the program, and I will comply with all JKHA Summer guidelines applicable to such transportation, which may include the obligation to wear face masks while in transit.

8. Financial implications:
- a. JKHA Summer has committed to provide a **full refund** of the program costs if, but only if, the program is cancelled before the first day of operations, whether by government order or by a decision of the Administration
 - b. If JKHA summer begins operation, but is subsequently at any time cancelled, interrupted, or truncated for any legitimate reason, whether due to government order or by a decision of the operators of JKHA Summer, there will be **no refund** of any portion of the cost of the program.
 - c. The Procedures may dictate that my child will be unable to attend any number of days of the program, including due to my or my child's failure to comply with the Procedures, my child's illness (or suspected illness), the illness (or suspected illness) of other children, or any other reasons as dictated by the Procedures, and there will be **no refund** for any such missed days.
9. Release. I release and give up any and all claims and rights which I, my child, or any member of my family may have against JKHA Summer, JKHA/RKYHS, or any of their respective employees or agents relating to my child's participation in JKHA Summer. It is my intention herein to construe this Acknowledgment and Release as broadly as possible to cover any and all issues relating to JKHA Summer. This releases all claims, including those of which I am not aware and those not mentioned in this Acknowledgment and Release.
