


Dear First Grader,

Dear Parents,

Welcome to First Grade! We look forward to a great year with you and your child. Our first day of school is **Wednesday, September 4th**. On **Tuesday, September 3rd**, we will be having a Parent & Child Visiting Day for you and your child. Please stop by anytime between **8:45 and 11:00 am** together with your child, and plan to stay for approximately ten minutes in the General Studies classroom and ten minutes in the Judaic Studies classroom. This is our chance to meet you and your child, to help your child unpack their supplies and become acquainted with the teachers and the classroom before the first day of school. If you ordered supplies from SchoolKidz, those supplies will be delivered directly to the classroom.

Below are some important notes about First Grade:

- Please send in two healthy snacks (peanut/nut free) and a roll of pennies to be kept in school for Tzedakah.
- On Tuesdays and Thursdays, meat lunches are served. Please make sure to send in a pareve afternoon snack.
- Please send in a change of LABELED clothes in a LABELED shoebox to be kept in your child's AM class. Occasionally, a muddy playground or a messy lunch might necessitate a change of clothes.
- Please send in 2 LABELED sweaters or sweatshirts to be left in each classroom in case the room is cool.
- Please label all folders (unless you ordered supplies through the school). We share all supplies as a classroom community.
- We recommend that you buy a backpack large enough to adequately hold your child's lunchbox, folders, and workbooks.
- Make sure you review all of your kindergarten high frequency words.
- Read a fairy tale on your own or with a grown up.
